

The John Evans Professorship Endowed Tuition Assistance Scholarship was established to help support the professional development of two students enrolled in the master's program in Biomedical Imaging who have a financial need and to support diversity and inclusion in the field of Radiology/STEM as a path to reducing healthcare disparities.

Each applicant's qualifications will be considered on an individual basis. Scholarships will be awarded to two recipients who self-identify as being from traditionally underrepresented groups in medicine and includes those categories as defined by the National Institutes of Health (diversity.nih.gov/about-us/population-underrepresented), including African American/Black, Hispanic/Latinx, American Indian/Native American, and Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander. The scholarship will cover 50% of the annual cost of tuition, or a maximum amount of \$40,000 to each awardee, and will be disbursed as payments per term (three terms per year) for a maximum of six total terms while a student is enrolled in the two-year program. This award is designed to align with our department's strong commitment to fostering diversity in healthcare providers for the future of academic medicine.
