- I will respect my professional relationship with the physician.
- I will share and expand knowledge within the profession.

These duties are pledged with sincerity and upon my honor.

HISTORY OF THE PROFESSION

The Physician Assistant (PA) profession began in the late 1960's at Duke University School of Medicine out of a need to provide quality healthcare to a greater number of people. As the need grew, physician assistant programs began in other medical schools around the country.

In 1973 Cornell University Medical College and The New York Hospital began the Surgeon Assistant Program. Founded by Dr. Peter Dineen, Professor of Surgery, the purpose was to educate qualified persons to be Surgeons Assistants. The Program remained with both institutions until 1989 at which time the Medical College assumed responsibility. In an effort to reflect its broad, based education and its alliance with the profession, Cornell University's Surgeon Assistant Program formally changed its name to a Physician Assistant Program A Surgical Focus in 1994. The Program's most recent accomplishment was incorporation in the Weill Cornell Graduate School of Medical Sciences, making this the thirteenth class eligible to receive a Master of Science in Health Sciences for Physician Assistant's degree.

Through their graduate level education in the basic and clinical sciences, Weill Cornell physician assistant students upon graduation are proficient in primary care and the surgical aspects of medicine. Our graduates are employed in a variety of clinical settings including academic medical centers, hospital based and private practice, HMO's and rural health care clinics.

After five decades of education, Physician Assistants have become a familiar and well-respected part of the health care team, working in all types of surgical and medical practices.

Today, we are proud to celebrate our 47th class of Physician Assistants.
