## Eligibility

- United States Citizen or Permanent Residents
- Under-represented minority in medicine (URiM), or from a disadvantaged socioeconomic background
- Not currently participating in NIH funded programs - e.g. T32

## Personalized Research Options

- 8 weeks of intensive summer research training in NYC, that provides an introduction to healthcare/scientific research fundamentals
- A mentored global health research experience
- Engaging in a mentored research project
